Paddy's Secret Wins the Sun City Handicap with Gutsy Effort

Endeavor Farm foaled, raised, and sales prepped Paddy's Secret has had a gr eat start to her four-year-old campaign in 2018. She started off the year with a decisive 4 3/4 length score in an allowance race at Turf Paradise on January 8th, then followed that up February 10th with a stakes win in the Sun City Handicap. The gray filly by Paddy O'Prado now has four wins from 11 starts, b ringing her total career earnings to \$58,995. Paddy's Secret was consigned by Vinery Sales in the 2015 Keeneland September yearling sale, where she was purchased for \$20,000 by Chris Randall. Her dam, farm resident Secret Humor (b y Yes It's True), just gave birth to a sharp chestnut filly by English Channel on February 8th. Congratulations to this filly's breeder, John Kuehl, who is a longtime client and friend of the farm. A job well done by her connections, jockey Daniel P. Vergara, trainer Frank Lucarelli, and owner Mike Bolduc.

A short yearling out of seasonal Endeavor Farm resident Princess Kate lit up the auction ring at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky February Mixed Sale, selling to De Meric Stables for a whopping \$220,000. The Into Mischief colt almost brought the highest price of any short yearling in the catalog, second only to a Tiznow colt. He was consigned by Stuart Morris. The bay colt was foaled at Endeavor Farm on March 1st of last year and he was a looker from day one. He is a typical Into Mischief, nice and correct with good bone. Princess Kate (by Orientate) is back at Endeavor Farm now in foal to Brody's Cause on a late March cover, so she is due to pop very soon. A huge congratulations to his breeders, David Meche, Tonya Jergens, Mark Toothaker, and Perry Judice. Way to hit the proverbial homerun! It might be a while before this young man sees a racetrack, but we will all be rooting for him when he does!
