Coming back strong in his second career start, Duplicity certainly looked the part as he broke his maiden decisively at Churchill Downs. The bay son of Into Mischief improved off his game debut race at Santa Anita in March, where he got edged at the wire to run second. Duplicity was bred by Cypress Bend Farm and was foaled and raised at Endeavor Farm. He was the first horse consigned by Endeavor Sales at Keeneland, where he fetched a final bid of \$220,000 in September 2018. Great job by trainer John Sadler and jockey Tyler Gaffalione.
