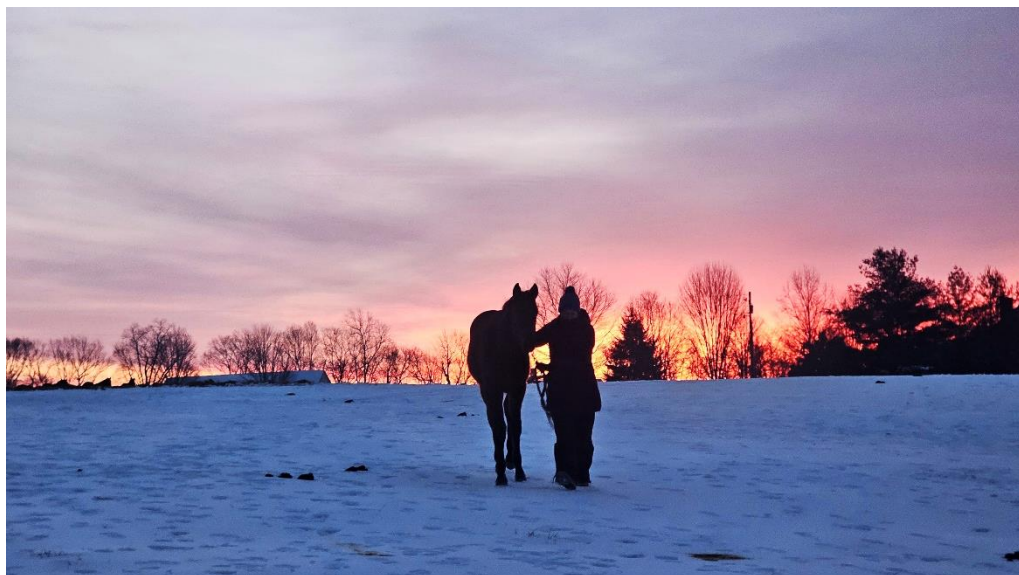

After battling tough traffic issues in his first several starts, Banker's Jet (Classic Empire - Poppy's Baby Girl (GB), by Yankee Victor) was finally able to put it all together to get his first career win at Gulfstream Park on January 11th. Jockey Tyler Gaffalione kept the three-year-old gelding out of trouble by keeping him on the lead throughout with an easy gate-to-wire score. Banker's Jet is trained by Mark Casse and was bred by Dr. Brad Tanner and Endeavor Farm. He was consigned by Endeavor Farm at the 2024 Fasig-Tipton February sale, where he achieved a final bid of \$43,000.

Woman's Intuition Smokes the Field at Will Rogers



Woman's Intuition (Connect - Breach of Duty, by Broken Vow) showed up at Will Rogers Downs on January 13th primed and ready to run. She held nothing back in her dominating maiden victory, taking the lead from the get-go and increasing her lead at every fraction to win by a whopping 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ lengths. Stellar training job by the team of Jerry Stephens and Hunter Cutshaw. Woman's Intuition is a homebred for Circle Bar H, LLC and was foaled and raised at Endeavor Farm. Her dam, Breach of Duty, is currently in foal to Frosted and will deliver in Oklahoma for the 2026 foaling season. Congrats to the team on the huge win!

Winning Becomes a Steady Habit for Viv's Wild Aces



Featured in last month's newsletter for her comeback win after a long layoff with an injury, Viv's Wild Aces (Hard Aces - I'm Wild, by Precocity) wasted no time getting right back into the winner's circle with another allowance score at Delta Downs on January 21st. The 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ length victory under pilot Vicente Del-Cid was good for another \$27,600 in earnings, bringing her total career bankroll to over \$140,000. Hats off to conditioner Antonio Alberto who has this filly back in top form after a lengthy stint away from the track. Third Time's a Charm for Huck's Agenda



Huck's Agenda (Known Agenda - Huckleberry, by Liam's Map) gave us all a reason to celebrate as she looked super sharp breaking her maiden at Fair Grounds on January 25th. Off as the 2/1 favorite, the three-year-old filly trailed the field until the final furlong where she rounded the pack seven-wide and laid down a surging bid to zip by her rivals to win by nearly four lengths. The maiden win comes on the heels of nice back-to-back third place efforts in her first two starts. Huck's Agenda was bred in Kentucky by Ashley Hiller and was foaled and raised at Endeavor Farm. She was a \$45,000 selection by Kenny McPeck from the Endeavor Farm consignment at the 2024 Fasig-Tipton October Sale. Huck's Agenda is the second foal out Huckleberry, a promising young broodmare by Liam's Map. Huckleberry's recently turned two-year-old by Drain the Clock sold last July for \$105,000 to Bourbon Lane. She is back in foal to Drain the Clock and has a yearling colt by Loggins.
