The bay colt broke well and settled in second, where he remained until the top of the stretch when he took the lead for good to win by 34 of a length in a final time of 1:25.40. Uncle James was purchased by Terry for client and current owner Paul Kessel from the 2014 Fasig-Tipton October yearling sale for \$50,000. Congratulations to the connections of this horse including trainer Wayne Catalano and jockey Channing Hill. Owner Paul Kessel also had another one of his horses, Six Schillings, run 2nd in an allowance at Keeneland the following day. He was also purchased by Terry from the same sale. Endeavor Farm foaled and raised Tiz Deliteful (Tiz Wonderful – Feline Delite, by Mineshaft) broke her maiden in impressive fashion in only her 2nd career start at Golden Gate Fields on October 22nd. The two-year-old filly got up at the last second to win the \$26,000 maiden special weight race by a nose, going 5 furlongs on the turf in 59.23. Tiz Deliteful made her debut back in August, when

she ran second on the all weather surface at Golden Gate going 5 ½ furlongs. She was purchased by Price Thoroughbreds out of the 2015 OBS August yearling sale for \$25,000, who pinhooked her and sold her again this spring for the same price. Congratulations to breeder Jan Adkinson, as well as jockey Julien Couton, trainer William Morey. Tiz Deliteful has a full sister who is a yearling of 2016 and we wish her the same racing success as her big sis!
