## Delitefull Hart Wastes No Time Returning to Form

A near 10-month layoff did not phase Delitefull Hart (Outwork - Delitefull Lady, by Dialed In) in the slightest, returning right back where she left off in top form. The bay filly won on debut last May then ran a solid third in her next start. 293 days later, Delitefull Hart returned to Santa Anita on April 4<sup>th</sup> to prove that she never missed a step, making short work of her allowance rivals to win her third career start by  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a length as the even money favorite. Delitefull Hart was foaled and raised at Endeavor Farm. She was bred by Paymaster Racing who still co-owns her along with Slugo Racing. Trainer Mike Puype had her looking sharp with a perfect ride by Mike Smith.

## Two More Winners for South Central Stables in April



Clyde Taylor’s South Central Stables has been a mainstay in the Winner’s Circle once again during the month of April! Two different winners carried the stable’s banner, both at Evangeline Downs. First was Cairo Charm (Cairo Prince - Mystic Charm, by War Pass) who got his first win in maiden special weight company in his first start at the track. Next up was Charlie’s Creed (Jimmy Creed - Misty Run, by Vindication), picking up his second career victory with a dominating performance as the heavy favorite. Fantastic work by trainer Keith Bourgeois and jockey Jose Rodriguez.

## Landlord Continues to Show Promise Early in His Career



Homebred Landlord (Lord Nelson - Vivian Da Bling, by Too Much Bling) has been most impressive in his brief three race career for J.R. & Rita Young.
